

WHAT COUNTY LIBRARY REALLY IS TOLD FULLY

Details of How It Will Operate Whom It Will Serve, Etc. Told in Statement by Committee.

In reply to the many questions that are being addressed to the committee in charge of county library activities in Morris County, as to what the county library is, how it will operate and whom it will serve, the following statement has been given out by the committee:

The matter of the County library will be voted upon at the November election. The question will be given space on the ballot and if the people approve the County Library at that time, it will mean that the county will own a collection of books chosen to serve all the people and all the interests of the county. These books will be divided into smaller collections and so distributed that every individual in the county will have easy access to them. Each collection will be kept fresh by constant exchange of books.

Instead of much money spent for small purpose for books by a number of communities and by many school and individuals, every community, organization, school and individual will be served with the books they need and desire from the county collection. The constant rotation of books will make one thousand books do the work of ten thousand.

The county will have a librarian who will be at the service of every individual and every organization in the county to see that they are provided with the

education while at school and to go on with their education after they leave school. It makes them more contented with their homes, and with county and small-town life. It provides good, wholesome pleasure which will keep boys and girls in their homes, and promotes family life by giving something both parents and children can use and enjoy. It teaches them the love of good literature and gives them high ideals. It starts them in life with equal footing with city children. It can be had for less than the cost of a new hair ribbon, a chicken dinner, a trip to the city, and for less than one-third the cost of a new dress or a new suit. A good start with a good equipment is the most important thing in life. In this day of strenuous life and keen competition, to deprive the coming generation of the slightest added advantage is to start them hampered in a long, hard race.

The New Jersey Public Library Commission endorses this movement because it believes that the county library is the most economical and efficient method of administering this work.

How a County Library is Established.—Upon the petition of three hundred voters, the County Board or Freeholders, at the next general or special election, must submit to the people the question as to whether they wish a county library.

What It will Cost.—The law says that if a majority of the votes cast are for a free public library, thereafter one-fifth of a mill on every dollar of assessable property shall be collected each year for its support. That means the library will cost one cent on \$50, two cents on \$100, sixty cents on \$3,000 of the assessed valuation of the property, which is about eighty per cent of its value. This is a fixed amount by law. This is less than the cost of one good book, less than half the subscription price of one good magazine, less than the price of two pounds of candy, one-fifth the price of the cheapest new hat. The funds so raised will be

will be sufficient to carry out the plan of the library as outlined above. It is an inexpensive proposition because it is the cooperative plan applied to books and information service.

The county will have a librarian who will be at the service of every individual and every organization in the county to see that they are provided with the necessary books and find information and advice for them on any problem that may confront them.

How it will be operated.—A collection of books with a reading room will be placed in all large communities.

Collections of books will be placed in grange halls, post offices, general stores, churches, schools and with all educational, civic, agricultural and commercial organizations to serve small communities and scattered population. By providing the librarian with a Ford car, she can exchange the books at small cost, visit each community and organization to see what books they want and get the books they desire to them within a short time. She can serve people living at distances from any centers directly from her car.

What it will bring the individual—It will bring all the books he needs in his work and the services of an expert in finding the best books and the information he wants. It will make his work easier and enable him to make more money. One farmer saved \$50 by the use of a book on greenhouse management. One farmer through the use of a book on corn raised \$3 per bushel for his corn. Others were getting \$1.50. One housewife, because of a book on canning, had not one single can of vegetables to spoil, and did her canning in two-thirds of the time her neighbors gave to the same work, and her neighbors lost from a tenth to a third of their canned vegetables. One boy, after studying three books on raising Belgian hares, went into the business of raising these hares and netted \$36 per month for one year while he was attending school. One boy won the prize offered by an advertising firm for the best cartoon and got a job with that firm through the use of one book on advertising and two on cartoon drawing.
