WHAT COUNTY LIBRARY REALLY IS TOLD FULLY

Details of How It Will Operate Whom It Will Serve, Etc. Told in Statement by Committee.

In reply to the many questions that are being addressed to the committee in charge of county library activities in Morris County, as to what the county library is, how it will operate and whom it will serve, the following statement has been given out by the committee:

The matter of the County library will be voted upon at the November election. The question will be given space on the ballot and if the people approve the County Library at that time, it will mean that the county will own : collection of books chosen to serve all the people and all the interests of the county. These books will be divided the smaller collections and so dis tributed that every individual in the county will have easy access to them Each collection will be kept freich b) constant exchange of books.

instead of much money spent to small purpose for books by a number of coramunities and by many school. and individuals, every community, or ganization, school and individual will be served with the books they need and desire from the county collection

The constant rotation of books will make one thousand books do the work of ten thousand.

The county will have a libraria who will be at the service of every in dividual and every organization in the county to see that they are prowided with the memore-

ducation while at school and to to on with their education after they leave school. It makes them nore contented with their homes, and with county and small-town life, It provides good, wholesome pleasare which will keep boys and girls n their homes, and promotes family life by giving something both parents and children can use and enjoy. It teaches them the love of good literature and gives them high ideals. It starts them in life with equal footing with city children. It can be had for less than the cost of a new hair ribbon, a chicken linner, a trip to the city, and for less than one-third the cost of a new dress or a new suit. A good start with a good equipment is the most important thing in life. In this day of strenuous life and keen competition, to deprive the coming reneration of the slightest added advantage is to start them hampered n a long, hard race.

The New Jersey Public Library Commission endorses this movement because it believes that the county library is the most economical and efficient method of administering his work.

How a County Library is Estab lished .- Upon the petition of three hundred voters, the County Board or Freeholders, at the next general or special election, must submit to the people the equestion as to whether they wish a county library.

What It will Cost .- The law says that if a majority of the votes cast are for a free public library, thereafter one-fifth of a mill on every dollar of assessable property shall be collected each year for its sup port. That means the library wil cost one cent on \$50, two cents on \$100, sixty cents on \$3,000 of the assessed valuation of the property. which is about eighty per cent of its value. How it will be operated. A col lection of books with a reading room will be placed in all large commun!-

Collections of books will be placed in grange halls, post offices, general stores, churches, schools and with all educational, civic, agricultural and commercial organizations to serve small communities and scattered population. By providing the librarian with a Ford car, she can exchange the books at small cost, visit each community and organization to sce what tooks they want and get the hooks hey desire to them within a short time. She can serve people living at distances from any centers directly from her car.

What it will bring the individual -It will bring all the books he needs in his work and the services of an expert in finding the best books and the information he wants.
