- Trips within Morris County and up to 5 miles outside county lines
  - VA Hospitals: Lyons and East Orange
- Suggested Donation \$2 per trip

# Nutrition Program Senior Farmers Market Vouchers

- This statewide program provides low-income seniors with a QR code, up to \$40 in value, to use towards the purchase of fresh fruit and vegetables at local farmers' markets in Morris County.
- Voucher eligibility determination and distribution of vouchers occurs from June 1<sup>st</sup> to September 30<sup>th</sup> each year.
- Vouchers can be redeemed at participating Farmers Market locations from June 1<sup>st</sup> to November 30<sup>th</sup> each year.


